Agriculture

- University of Central Missouri: Dual credit in Plant Science for 1 credit (begins 2023-2024)
- Metropolitan Community Colleges: Articulated credit in Introduction to Agriculture.

Automotive Technology

- Metropolitan Community Colleges: Articulated credit in Automotive Electrical Systems, Automotive Braking Systems, and Suspension and Steering

Criminal Justice

- State Fair Community College: Dual credit in Introduction to Criminal Justice and Introduction to Law Enforcement for up to 6 credits.
