The Harrisonville High School Freshman Mentoring Program will use its portion of the proceeds to fund the Christina Collins Memorial Scholarship. Christina Collins was a 2006 graduate of Harrisonville High School who died in a car accident during spring 2007. While in high school, Collins was a member of the marching band, tutoring, the Freshman Mentoring Program, cheerleading and softball.

## Sustaining Donors provide gifts to continue programs

Ten years ago, the Harrisonville Public School Foundation established a General Endowment meant to maintain Foundation programs in perpetuity. The endowment's funding goal is \$500,000. The initial fundraising campaign goal aimed to find 100 Founding Donors, who would each give \$1,000 to the endowment. After completing that goal, the foundation raised more than \$200,000 for the endowment.

The second phase of expanding the endowment is the Sustaining Donors campaign. Once again, the Foundation is seeking 100 donors to give \$1,000 to the Foundation. Currently, 26 Sustaining Donors (see list on pages 6-7) have participated, and the overall en-

dowment has grown to total approximately \$347,000. Sustaining Donor contributions can be structured as a one-time gift of \$1,000 or two annual gifts of \$500.

General Endowment funds are restricted. Only interest earned is used to support Foundation programs. Some programs supported by the Foundation during the past few years have included:

- Award Excellence in Academics Scholarships to seniors who complete all four years of high school in the top 15 percent of their class. The Foundation awards \$500 to each student. In 2016, students received \$12,000 in total, and since 2003, the Foundation has awarded \$142,000.

- Provide teacher grants to district teachers to purchase materials and resources that support and enhance educational programs and activities. The Foundation has given \$8,000 in 2016 and more than \$76,000 during the past 13 years.

- Offer Advanced Degree Teacher reimbursement to help teachers seeking advanced degrees in non-administrative fields. Since 2008, the Foundation has provided more than \$27,000 for this program.

- Give student scholarships to attend the Missouri Scholars Academy and the Hugh O'Brian Youth Leadership Seminar.

- Fund district grants that have totaled more than \$43,000 during the past three years. Items pur-

chased include Chromebooks, iPads, and garden bars.

All donors are recognized in Foundation newsletters and on the Foundation website. Donors are also honored with a leaf on the Tree of Knowledge located in the HHS Performing Arts Center lobby.

# Students honored for academic achievement

More than 150 Harrisonville High School students were honored for their academic achievement at an assembly on August 31. The Excellence in Academics Assembly recognized students who earned an academic letter and those who earned the Excellence in Academics medallion during the 2015-16 school year. The assembly was co-sponsored by the Harrisonville Public School Foundation and the HHS Academic Booster Club. The daytime assembly was

attended by the entire HHS student body, parents, and community members.

The Foundation's Excellence in Academics program honors students who complete the year in the top 15 percent of their class. Those students receive the Excellence in Academics medallion.

Underclassmen are recognized with an assembly each August, and seniors are honored during the Senior Excellence in Academics Ceremony in May. Those students earning the

Excellence in Academics recognition all four years of high school earn a \$500 scholarship from the Foundation. Four-year recipients may choose to use the scholarship to "pay it forward" instead of using the scholarship monies themselves. In that case, they can designate the funds as a grant to a school program that positively influenced their lives.

# Foundation presents teacher grants for fall 2016

Teachers and students in the Harrisonville School District recently received more than \$4,500 in grants from the Harrisonville Public School Foundation.

Throughout the 13 years of the teacher grant program, more than \$76,000 has been presented to teachers. The goal of the program is to enhance the education of Harrisonville students by encouraging and recognizing new educational approaches and concepts that are not currently funded by the district.

The grants were awarded in a surprise squad format with Foundation trustees surprising the teachers in their classrooms and presenting them with a check.

Teacher grants were awarded to the following:

- Caitlynn Compton, HMS

art, to purchase three Chromebooks to be used exclusively in the art program to research and assist in art-making. Students will also use the computers for graphic design.

- Jason Walters, HMS social studies, to purchase equipment for a digital media lab to enable students to create and manipulate media content for projects.

- Rebecca Reeser, District Speech/Language, to fund sensory integration materials for the district's special education classrooms to help children channel energy, keep blood flow going to the brain during instructional times, and also help regulate emotions in response to sensory input.

- Leslie Culpepper and Tina Perne, HES, to continue implementation of flexible seating in the teachers' classrooms. Flexible seat-



ing allows students to work where they feel comfortable and encourages collaboration and cooperative learning activities.

- Jenny Wickstrom, HHS foreign language, to expand the Spanish and French book library available to high school students. This grant was funded through the Cade Filer Teacher Grant Endowment.

- Missy Eddleman, McEowen (pictured above), to purchase a document camera for use in her classroom as a way to display and collaborate on lessons. This grant was funded through the Velma Stephens Elementary Teacher Grant Endowment.

## New teachers receive mini-grants to help with classroom set-up

c. Has demonstrated service in the community in which he/she lives.

5. A personal statement of 250 words or less by the nominator that describes the nominee's impact and contribution that warrant the nominee's selection to the Wall of Fame.

6. Any supporting material such as newspaper articles, stories, letters of recommendation, etc. should be submitted with the nomination form. The selection committee will review only the in-

formation provided and will not do further research.

7. The committee will score the nominee's main area of nomination (exemplary achievement, honors & awards, service to the community). Nominees will earn bonus points for work in areas beyond the primary nomination area.

### Nomination/Selection Procedure

Anyone may nominate a graduate for consideration.

Nomination files will be discarded if no new materials have been added for three years after a nomination.
